## EATA RESEARCH COMMITTEE MISSION:

The mission of the Eastern Athletic Trainers' Association Research Committee is to: (1) disseminate knowledge by delivering research findings through diverse and effective educational and scholarly programming, and (2) to stimulate, promote, support and fund quality research that has the potential to enhance the clinical practice or support best practice and ultimately advance the profession of athletic training.

NOTE: NATA membership and BOC certification are EATA requirements for committee inclusion. Individuals must be members of District 1 or District 2. Members must have an NPI number.

## EATA Research Committee Membership *Minimum* Requirements/Qualifications:

Specific degree requirements have been waived. Individuals must demonstrate a history of scholarly experience that should *include* but not limited to:

- (1) Demonstration of abstract submission or experience in reviewing abstracts
- (2) Demonstration of a grant submission or experience in reviewing grant submissions
- (3) Demonstration in a scientific manuscript submission or in reviewing scientific manuscripts

Any individual meeting the *experience* inclusion criteria will be considered for membership by the EATA-Research Committee. Selections will be made based on the experience profile and current committee needs. Please submit a letter of interest to the EATA-President.
