Proposal Deadlines & Format

1. All proposals are due for review by **May 31, 2021**
2. Final decisions will be determined by **July 15, 2021**.
3. All proposals must be submitted online through the submission web site portal.
4. You are **REQUIRED** to upload the CV for ALL presenters as well as a short speaker biography for ALL presenters. **Only PDF files will be accepted.**
5. **SUBMISSION MUST BE DONE IN ONE SITTING.** You cannot save and return later.
